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


Cooperatives The economic organisation with the most members

With 20 million members and more than 1,00,000 employees the 7,000 cooperatives are a driving force for the economy and society.

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

Cooperative banks stand for trust and a solid business model. All over Germany they offer their 30 million customers comprehensive financial services.


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Cooperative banks A solid business model


